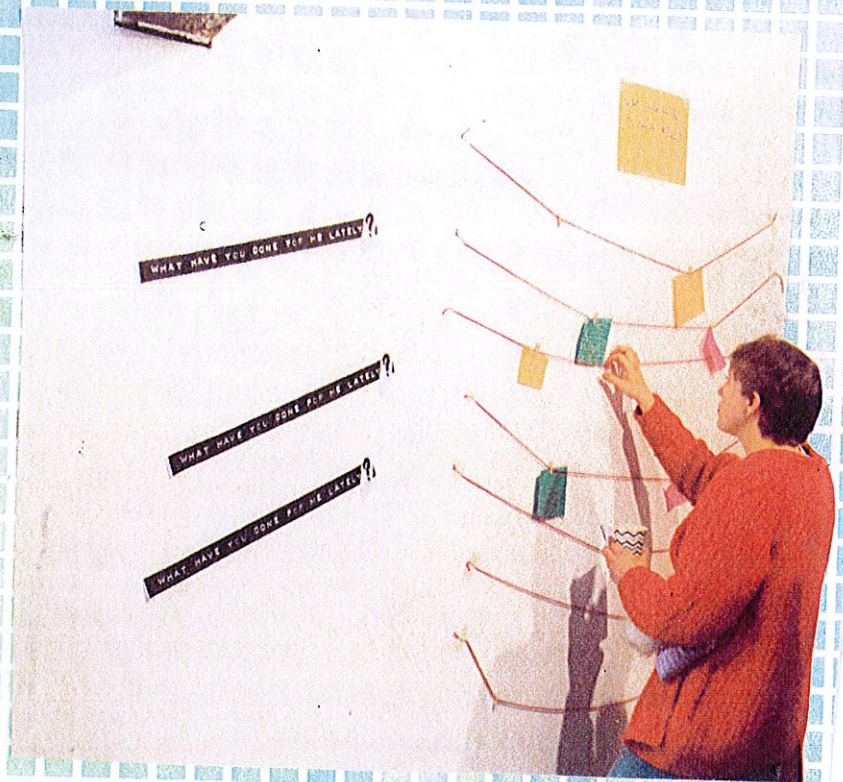
• What Have You Done For Me Lately? draws attention to the issue of allyship which is a staple of conversation around queer identity.

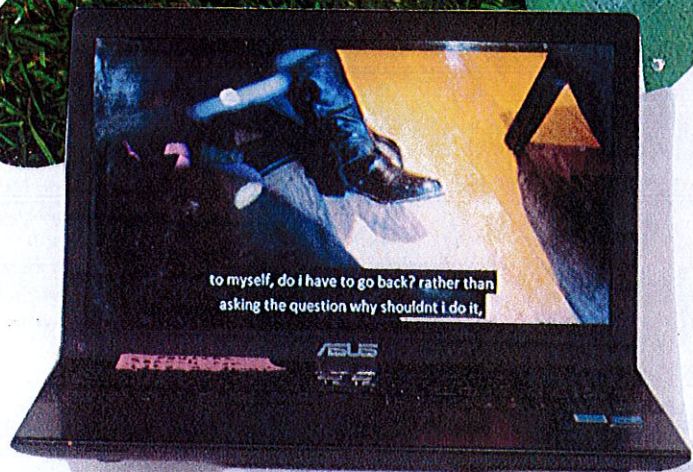
We're outnumbered 100 to 1.
